(Words you might want to post in preparation for College Day.)

College Word	Definition
a-g Requirements	Courses that you can take in middle and high school to become eligible to go to a 4 year college right after high school.
Application	A form used for making a request. A college application requests admission to a college.
College	A school higher than high school.
College Exams	Tests that you need to take in order to get into college.
Degree	A title given to a student by a college, university, or professional school upon completion of a program of study.
Dorm or Dormitory	A residence hall with many sleeping rooms. Many colleges have dorms where students can live while they study.
Financial Aid	Money to support a worthy person or cause.
Grade Point Average (GPA)	The average obtained by dividing the total number of grade points earned by the total number of credits taken.
Major	A main subject studied by a student.
Mascot	A person, animal or object that is supposed to bring good luck.
Motto	A short expression that is used as a guiding rule of conduct (behavior).
Post-Secondary Education	Any school you attend after high school.
Professor	A teacher at a college or university.
Scholarships	Money given (as by a college) to a student to help pay for further education.
Study Abroad	The ability to study in another country while you are in college.
University	An institution of higher learning that grants degrees in special fields (as law or medicine) as well as in the arts and sciences.
